Your child will receive a math practice booklet to help hone math skills during vacation. Third grade teachers will expect students to know addition and subtraction facts.

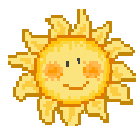
Cursive handwriting is another skill that requires consistent practice and use over the summer.
